


GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY PSYC101 003 Fall 2015 No. of responses = 211/295 (Response Rate:71.53%)







- David Penn is an amazing professor and is one of the best lecturers I have had the privileged to listen to.
- Dr. Penn does a fantastic job at engaging with students during lectures. Despite the large class size (200-250), he puts effort into getting to know each student individually (e.g. he remembers the names of those participating). Dr. Penn's lectures are very well timed out: He does not get sidetracked or ramble on. He brings the point across, explains concepts in great detail so that everybody gains a better understanding of the subject matter, and gladly answers students' questions. You can tell that he is passionate about the field of Psychology and genuinely enjoys sharing his knowledge with others. I really appreciated his teaching style: His PowerPoint slides were aesthetically pleasing, he spoke slowly and clearly, repeating definitions multiple times so everyone would have enough time to take notes, and he showed us very well-chosen YouTube videos to convey the message once more. The fact that he switched things up during lectures made class all the more enjoyable and interesting. Dr. Penn's humorous manner and level of expertise made Psych 101 absolutely delightful.


